THINGS TO REMEMBER

FRIDAY – We will have our 'Forest School' sessions on Friday morning. Please send your child into school wearing clothing suitable for the weather (wellies and waterproofs, or sun hat and sun cream). Also please send a bag of spare clothes.

WATER BOTTLES: Please send your child to nursery with a freshly filled named water bottle every day. Please ensure water bottles are filled with only **water**.

HOMEWORK: Children in nursery will not receive weekly homework. However, we encourage parents to share children's home experiences with us which we can use towards evidence of their learning. Please share photos on class dojo for me to see.
