**HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD**

- Read with your child at home. If possible, please read a story to your child every day.
- Talk with your child at every opportunity. This will help to develop listening, speaking and understanding skills.
- Encourage your child to develop their independence, encouraging them to use the toilet independently, walk into nursery independently and put on their own coat.
- Collect items to show, related to topics being taught in class.
- We have been learning about rhyming words. Singing nursery rhymes and reading rhyming stories together will help your child to develop this skill.

**THINGS TO REMEMBER**
