HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD

- Read with your child at home. If possible, please read a story to your child every day.
- Talk with your child at every opportunity. This will help to develop listening, speaking and understanding skills.
- Encourage your child to develop their independence, encouraging them to use the toilet independently, walk into nursery independently, use a knife and fork when eating and put on their own coat.
- Collect items to show, related to topics being taught in class.
- At this stage, it is important that children are starting to hear sounds in words, eg, initial and final sounds. Please play lots of rhyming games and initial sound games with your child to help develop this skill.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

FRIDAY – We will have our 'Forest School' sessions on Friday morning. Please send your child into school wearing clothing suitable for the weather (wellies and waterproofs, or sun hat and sun cream). Also please send a bag of spare clothes.

UNIFORM: Please make sure that your child's uniform is **clearly labelled**; we have so many children that items of uniform are easily lost. Children with long hair must have it tied back in a hair bobble.

WATER BOTTLES: Children can bring a water bottle containing **water**.

HOMEWORK: Children in nursery will not receive weekly homework. However, we encourage parents to share children's home experiences with us which we can use towards evidence of their learning. Please upload home learning onto Class Dojo.

SNACK: All children in EYFS are offered fruit each day, these vary from raisins, pears, apples etc. In addition to this, we also provide a

Understanding the World:
